Australia's NSW State Government owns and operates major sporting and recreation facilities at various locations throughout the state. Page Kirkland Group was contracted to develop an over-arching 5-year Asset Strategic Plan as well as individual Asset Strategic Plans for eleven sport and recreation centres.

**Key challenges:** The plan needed to align with each centre's overall business plan; the Department's overall corporate and service delivery strategy; conform to the NSW Treasury Results and Services Plan; and, provide information in a compatible format for Treasury. The project involved thorough analysis of proposed asset strategies and the implementation of NSW Government's total asset management framework to improve delivery of services.

**Outcomes:** A clear and concise plan that ensures investment in each centre is appropriately managed over the long term; and, the identification of appropriate funding for each centre's specific asset management needs.
